

The Fraser Centre Community Trust: Photography & Live Film Policy

This policy relates to the capture of photography and film by The Fraser Centre Community trust for use in our reporting or marketing purposes.

Use of images

The use of images may be used online and offline such as but not limited to:

- Social media and website posts.
- Funding reports, annual reports.
- Posters for future events.

Employees at The Fraser Centre Community Trust with a relevant job requirement to access photos/films will be permitted access to use photography/film.

Ticketed / Registered Events & Activities

The Fraser Centre community Trust shall ask participants in ticketed or registered events for permission OR adequate signage shall be displayed upon entrance to the premises.

People who have declined to be photographed or filmed will be removed from photos.

Open Events / Services

Photography and filming may occur in public areas for reporting and marketing purposes without the need for consent such as the café or open festival events. Permission may not be requested beforehand for open events such as our café.

Specific photos/films of children or vulnerable adults will not be used without permission.

Third Parties

Photography / Film may be shared with funders to record as evidence activities relating to funding.

Photography / Film will not be shared with third parties (with the exception of funders highlighted above) unless outlined in the permission.

Data Protection
